Quick Operation Guide 0: Normal running position of the watch 1: Rotate the crown to adjust the hour and minute hands Time Setting 1.1 Pull the crown out to the first position to stop the second hand at the zero mark (12 o'clock position). If the watch has no second hand, you may pull the crown out directly. 1.2 Rotate the crown to adjust the hour and minute hands. For precise time setting, first turn the minute hand 5 minutes ahead of your target time, then rotate the crown counterclockwise back to the desired time. 1.3 After adjusting the hour and minute hands, cross-check with standard time. Push the crown back to the normal running position the moment the standard time hits 0 second, and the second hand will start moving again. How To Pair (iOS device) Note: iOS or macOS with the latest version. 2.1 Place the device next to your Apple device like iPhone. 2.2 Turn on Bluetooth on iPhone and connect to the Internet. 2.3 Press and hold the 'power button' for 2 seconds, and	you will hear a beep indicating successful power-on. 2.4 Open the 'Find My' app. 2.5 In the Find My app, tap Add Item, then select Other Supported Items. 2.6 Once the device is located, tap 'connect' . 2.7 Enter a name and choose an emoji for the device. Tap 'Continue'. 2.8 Find My will ask for confirmation to add the device to your Apple ID. Tap 'Agree'. 2.9 Tap 'Finish' and the device will be set up and ready to be used. How To Pair (Android device) Note: It requires an Android smartphone that supports Google Play Services and runs on Android 9 or later. 3.1 Search and download the Find Hub app on Google Play. 3.2 Ensure that your phone has location services enabled, Bluetooth turned on, is connected to the internet, logged into a Google Account, and has the "Find Hub" feature activated. 3.3 Open "Find Hub" app. 3.4 Place your device near your Android device. 3.5 Press and hold the 'power button' for 2 seconds, and	you will hear a beep indicating successful power-on. 3.6 Wait for a half-screen notification to appear, then follow the on-screen instructions on your Android device to add the the device to Find Hub. Battery The device contains a coin shaped battery. During the product's lifespan, it may be necessary to replace the battery. By observing the correct negative and positive connections, only replace batteries of the same type (CR2032) and rating. Battery replacement 4.1 Unscrew the screws with a screwdriver and remove them to open the rear cover. 4.2 Install a new battery. 4.3 Fit and close the rear cover securely. Additional Tips 5.1 To switch from working mode to disabled mode (Flight Mode), simply power off the device: press and hold the button for approximately 6 seconds, then release it once the device emits a beep pattern of "beep, beep-beep, beep-beep-beep". 5.2 To switch from disabled mode (Flight Mode) to working	mode, please power on the device again: press and hold the button for approximately 2 seconds, then release it once the device emits a single "beep"; the device will enter pairing mode, and note that if no connection is established within 2 minutes, it will time out and require a restart. 5.3 Factory Reset: Press and hold the button – do not release it after hearing the continuous beep pattern of "beep, beep-beep, beep-beep-beep"; keep holding until a long beep is heard, then release. Note that a timeout will occur after 2 minutes. 5.4 To remove this device from your Apple device: Open the "Find My" app, select "Items", tap on the device, then scroll down and tap "Remove This Device". 5.5 To remove this device from your Android device: Open the "Find Hub" app, tap on the device you want to remove, then tap the "Settings" button in the top-right corner. Tap "Remove from Find Hub" at the bottom of the interface, and then tap the "Remove" button. Once the device is removed successfully, it will emit a "beep-beep" prompt, and a "Device Removed" pop-up will appear on your phone. 5.6 If this device fails to connect to the App, follow the instructions in Section 5.3 to perform a factory reset, then restart the pairing process.
